

**City Council
Work Session Minutes
Jacksonville, Alabama
January 9, 2023**

The Council of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, met on January 9, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. for a Regular Work Session. Council President Tony K. Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. The following Council Members were present: Coty Galloway, Andrew Green, Sherry Laster, and Terry Wilson. Mayor Johnny L. Smith, City Administrator Albertha Grant, City Attorney Richard Rhea, and City Clerk Brenda Long were present.

MINUTES. No changes to the minutes.

HVAC SYSTEM AT COMMUNITY CENTER – JANIS BURNS. Janis Burns introduced Heather Page with Whorton Engineering to give an update on the HVAC System replacement/repair at the Community Center. After an extensive discussion, the Council requested to move forward with bidding the job out.


GARBAGE BILLING RATES. Mayor explained the substantial increase in garbage and health/sanitation fees for the citizens. This increase is due to the re-bidding of the contract after the expiration of the previous contract. Because the first bill due in February will be for services in December and January, it will be prorated in the amount of \$17.29 for garbage and \$7.86 for health/sanitation fees. Beginning with the bill due in March, rates will increase to the new contracted charge of \$20.85 for garbage and \$9.48 for health/sanitation fees.


OTHER BUSINESS. Council President Taylor asked if there was any other business.

- Mayor informed the Council of the removal of the transfer of the Henry Farm Baseball Property from the agenda.
